CLASS CONSTITUTIONS

Class Advisors' Suggestions

Text in *italics* are suggested additions.

- **II Sec. 4** (1) The affairs of the Class Council shall be recorded in the minutes by the Secretary, as will the outcomes of all the votes held there. All votes shall be public votes and made public knowledge, preferably with the individual yeas and nays of each voting member being recorded and published. (2) Should the Class Council find it necessary to withhold the names and/or numbers of a vote, they may hold a vote to keep them secret. However, that vote for secrecy itself must be a public vote.
- **III Sec. 1** All Class Elections shall be held no earlier than the *second* Monday of May and no later than the first Monday of June. No Class may hold its Elections prior to the SGO Elections of the same year. *The above nonwithstanding, the incoming freshman class shall hold their elections no later than the first Monday of October.*
- **Sec. 9** Candidates for Class Representative do not need petitions, but must make their intent to run known by the same date as the Officers' petitions are due. Candidates for Representative are also not required to make a speech. If there are six or less volunteers, no Election is necessary. The Election shall be run with voters voting for any six out of the available candidates; the six candidates with the highest vote totals shall become the Representatives. Otherwise, the procedures for electing Representatives shall be the same as that for electing the Officers.
- **V Sec. 10** A Class Representative can be expelled by vote of at least three-quarters (75%) of the Class Council, or by petition of no less than one-third (33%) of the general Student Body of that Class. The Representative shall be replaced by the victor of an Election of the general Student Body of that Class.
