

Resolution of the SGO

I. Short Title

This act may be referred to as “The Supplementary Website Policy Act of 2002,” amending the Website Policy Act of 2002.

II. Acceptable Use

Sec. 1 As the SGO Messageboard is meant as a forum for discussion on matters of interest to the North Shore community, posts that have no appreciable connection to the North Shore community shall be called irrelevant and may be deleted.

Sec. 2 Unsolicited advertising refers to unauthorized posting of advertisements of any kind by persons outside the North Shore community, or posting advertisements that have no relevance to the North Shore community, and is prohibited. The Webmaster in consultation with the SGO Council, President, and Faculty Advisor may regulate these and any other categories of advertising.

Sec. 3 Unauthorized disclosure refers to posts that disclose private information about another person. These posts will be deleted at the request of that person, but this type of post may be deleted even without a person’s request.

Sec. 4 If the author of a post wishes to have one of their own posts removed, he may contact the Webmaster who *at his discretion* may delete the post.

III. Other Policy

Sec. 1 Pertaining to the Federal Communications Decency Act, it is emphasized that the SGO Messageboard is not a continuously moderated messageboard. A post shall be considered unmoderated until it is viewed by a person designated by the North Shore SGO or the Webmaster as a Moderator.

Sec. 2 The Webmaster shall have the authority to appoint other persons to a Web Development Team as he sees fit.

Sec. 3 Unless otherwise specified in the Website Policy Act of 2002 or related legislation, all motions regarding the Website must be passed in written form.
